**Statement of Gustavo Bamberger and Lynette Neumann**

1. I, Gustavo Bamberger, am a Senior Vice President of Lexecon, an economics consulting firm that specializes in the application of economics to legal and regulatory issues. I received a B.A. degree from Southwestern at Memphis, and M.B.A. and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Chicago Graduate School of Business. I have previously provided expert testimony to the U.S. Federal Communications Commission (“the Commission”). I also have provided expert testimony to the U.S. Senate, the U.S. Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, the U.S. Department of Transportation, the U.S. International Trade Commission, the Canadian Competition Tribunal, the High Court of New Zealand, state regulatory agencies and federal courts. My curriculum vitae is attached as Attachment A to this statement.

2. I, Lynette Neumann, am a Vice President of Lexecon. I received a B.A. degree from Millikin University, and M.S. and Ph.D. degrees from Cornell University. My curriculum vitae is attached as Attachment B to this report.

3. We have been asked by counsel for DIRECTV, Inc. to calculate the changes in concentration that would result from the proposed transactions (the “Transactions”) in which the cable assets of Adelphia Communications Corporation (“Adelphia”) would be acquired (directly and indirectly) by Comcast Corporation (“Comcast”) and Time Warner Cable Inc. (“Time Warner”), and Comcast and Time Warner would exchange other cable assets.

4. Comcast and Time Warner are both multichannel video programming distributors (“MVPDs”). MVPD firms compete in two separate (but related) product markets: (1) the “distribution market” (i.e., selling MVPD services to consumers); and (2) the “programming market” (i.e., buying programming from content providers). The Transactions will not directly reduce the number of sellers in any MVPD distribution market; however, the Transactions will increase concentration in regional programming markets, which can have a direct effect on the programming markets and an indirect effect on competition in the distribution market.

5. Many programming services – for example, HBO, ESPN, the Discovery Channel – are sold on a national basis. Other programming services – in particular, regional sports networks (“RSNs”) – are sold primarily on a regional basis. RSNs typically are available for viewing only within a regional area, often referred to as the RSN “footprint.”<sup>1</sup> Thus, the relevant geographic market for an RSN is no broader than the RSN’s footprint.

6. We analyze the effect of the Transactions on concentration in geographic markets defined by RSN footprints for 29 RSNs.<sup>2</sup> We have access to subscriber information by MVPD in each Designated Market Area (“DMA”) in the United States, but not by RSN footprint.<sup>3</sup> For this reason, we estimate subscriber shares in each RSN footprint by combining information

1. RSNs typically are available on “basic tiers.” RSN programming is sometimes available outside of an RSN footprint through premium packages (e.g., MLB Extra Innings).
  2. FSN West and FSN West 2 have the same RSN footprint, and so we treat them as one RSN in this analysis.
  3. Every household in the United States is in one of 210 non-overlapping DMAs. The Commission has previously defined the relevant geographic market for broadcast programming as the DMA for each individual broadcast station. See *News-Hughes*, 19 FCC Rcd. 473 at ¶¶ 65-66 (2004).

on the geographic extent of each RSN's footprint (i.e., which DMAs are included in the RSN's footprint) and information on MVPD subscribers by DMA.<sup>4</sup>

7. We estimate subscriber shares in each footprint as follows:
  - We rely on subscriber information from Media Business Corp. ("MBC"). For each DMA, MBC estimates the number of subscribers for the 10 largest cable providers in the DMA; all other cable providers; and DBS operators.<sup>5</sup>
  - We determine which Adelphia systems would be acquired by Comcast, which would be acquired by Time Warner, and which would be "swapped" between Comcast and Time Warner from press releases and the list provided to the Commission by Comcast and Time Warner on June 21, 2005. In Table 1, we report the number of subscribers, by DMA, acquired by Comcast from Adelphia; the number acquired by Time Warner from Adelphia; the number acquired (directly or indirectly) by Comcast from Time Warner; and the number acquired (directly or indirectly) by Time Warner from Comcast as a result of the proposed transaction.<sup>6</sup>
  - We received information on the zip codes included in 25 RSN footprints; for the remaining four RSNs, we assume that the RSN footprint consists of the counties in which each RSN is available (as reported on the four RSN websites). See Tables 2A and 2B.

4. For 25 RSNs, we received information on the geographic extent of the RSN's footprint from DIRECTV. For four RSNs (Carolina Sports Entertainment Television; Channel 4 San Diego; Comcast Sports Net Philly and Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast), we determined the geographic extent of the RSN's footprint from each RSN's website. We also understand that there are some new RSNs for which information is not available to us (e.g., Mets Network, Falconvision, Bravesvision, and Cowboys TV).

5. The MBC database does not separately report subscribers by DBS provider. We assume that DIRECTV, Inc. accounts for 56 percent of DBS subscribers in every DMA (and EchoStar the remaining 44 percent).

6. We note that the number of Comcast and Time Warner subscribers per DMA is not consistent across all three sources of information (i.e., MBC, Comcast and Time Warner estimates).

- We determine the county in which each zip code is located.<sup>7</sup>
- We determine the DMA in which each county is located.<sup>8</sup>
- We allocate MVPD subscribers in each DMA to the counties that make up the DMA in proportion to the counties' populations. For example, suppose that MVPD A has 1,000 subscribers in a particular DMA. Also suppose that this DMA is made up of three counties, C1, C2 and C3. If the populations of these counties are 600,000 in C1, 300,000 in C2 and 100,000 in C3, we assume that MVPD A has 600 subscribers in county C1, 300 in C2 and 100 in C3.<sup>9</sup>
- Finally, we include in the RSN footprint every county that includes a zip code in the RSN footprint.<sup>10</sup> We calculate each MVPD's subscribers in the RSN's footprint by aggregating MVPD subscribers for every county included in the RSN footprint.

8. Based on our estimates of subscribers by RSN footprint, we estimate each MVPD's subscriber shares in each RSN footprint. Using these shares, we calculate the effect of the Transactions on the Herfindahl-Hirschman Index ("HHI") for each RSN footprint. The HHI equals the sum of the squared shares of each firm in the relevant market. For example, if there are three firms in a market, with shares of 50, 30 and 20 percent, the HHI for that market equals 50 squared plus 30 squared plus 20

7. The zip code database we rely on maps each zip code in the United States to a unique "most prevalent county" (see <http://www.zipinfo.com/products/z5max/z5max.htm>).

8. Each county in the United States is assigned to only one DMA (with the exception of seven counties; these counties account for only about 1.2 percent of total U.S. population – four of these counties are located in California; one each is located in Arizona, New Mexico and New York).

9. This assumption will understate concentration measured at the county level to the extent that MVPDs in a DMA tend to be concentrated in one or more counties.

10. We use this assumption for the 25 RSNs whose footprints are defined by zip code. (At least one zip code in the counties we assign to a county-based RSN footprint will be in the zip code-based RSN footprint, but one or more zip codes in those counties may not be in the zip code-based RSN footprint.) For the other four RSNs, we assume that the entire county is in the RSN's footprint.

squared, or  $2,500 + 900 + 400 = 3,800$ .<sup>11</sup> The HHI for a market ranges from approximately zero (for “atomistic” competition) to 10,000 (for a monopoly). See Table 3.<sup>12</sup>

11. After aggregating all MVPD firms’ subscribers in the RSN footprint, we assume that the “others” category is made up of one percent firms (for example, if the “others” category accounts for seven percent of the subscribers in the RSN footprint, I assume that “others” is made up of seven MVPD firms that each account for one percent of the subscribers in the footprint; thus, the contribution of the “others” category to the HHI calculation for the footprint equals 7 times  $(1.0)^2 = 7.0$ ).
12. We also calculate the effect of the transaction on HHI at the DMA level. See Table 4.
