At the request of the Commission's staff, AT&T Corp. ("AT&T") is providing certain additional information to supplement the responses that AT&T provided to the Commission's April 18, 2005 Information and Document Request. The exhibits are being provided both in hard copy and on CD-ROM. Please find enclosed one (1) set of hard copies and five (5) copies of the CD.

Specification 1(c). AT&T is providing a supplemental version of Exhibit 1(c) that provides, for each of several revenue ranges, the number of business customers, the total billed revenue in that range, and the percentage of AT&T's total 2004 revenue each range represents. The customer counts and revenues are slightly higher than in the original Exhibit 1(c), because this new exhibit includes government customers that were not included in the original. This exhibit is confidential subject to the *First Protective Order* in this proceeding,¹ and copying is prohibited.

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Specification 3(a)(1). Definitions for the terms used in Columns E and F in Exhibit 3(a)-I and 3(a)-II are provided in Attachment A to this letter.

AT&T is also providing a revised version of Exhibit 3(a)-I, which indicates the customer segment in addition to the information previously provided. The customer counts and revenue reported here are slightly different from the original chart, because the new chart is based on more current information. For example, some customer records that were missing a segment designation and/or location information (*i.e.*, zip code) needed to assign a customer to a specific location have become available and can now be included. This exhibit is subject to the *Second Protective Order* in this proceeding,² and copying is prohibited.

Specification 3(b). AT&T is submitting a revised version of Exhibit 3(b)-II that adds the number, name and state of the identified MSA. There is no other change in the information. This exhibit is confidential subject to the *First Protective Order*, and copying is prohibited.

Specification 3(c). AT&T is submitting a revised version of Exhibit 3(c) that adds the following information: (1) the MSA number for each MSA and (2) each circuit by bandwidth type. This exhibit is confidential subject to the *Protective Order*, and copying is prohibited.

Specification 4. Definitions for the terms used in Columns B and C of Exhibit 4 are provided in Attachment A.

AT&T is submitting revised versions of Exhibits 4-I, 4-II, and 4-III that add an identification of the market segment of the customer, where available. This exhibit is confidential subject to the *First Protective Order*, and copying is prohibited.

AT&T is also submitting a revised Exhibit 4 which adds the names and billing addresses of the customers in each identified bidding situation. This revised chart is highly confidential subject to the *Second Protective Order*, and copying is prohibited.

Specification 5(c). AT&T is submitting a revised version of Exhibits 5(c)-I through 5(c)-V, which adds the MSA number for each MSA. AT&T is also submitting new reports for both April and May 2005. These revised charts are highly confidential subject to the *Second Protective Order*, and copying is prohibited.

Specification 16. AT&T clarifies that the subscriber and other data provided in these exhibits are as of the end of the month.

Specification 16(b). AT&T is submitting revised versions of Exhibits 16(b)-I through 16(b)-V and Exhibit 16(d) that provide data for every state (rather than only the states in SBC's

Summary Service Description/ Detailed Service Description

Data Services

- **Domestic Bandwidth LD:** Long-Haul Private Line service of various speeds from 9.6Kbps to 10 Gbps in full duplex, point to point or multipoint configurations.
- **Domestic Bandwidth Local:** Local Private Line services, as above.
- **Domestic Packet LD:** Long-Haul High Speed Packet Services consisting of Frame Relay and Asynchronous Transfer Mode (ATM). Covers voice, data, video and Multimedia applications.
- **Domestic Packet Local:** Local High Speed Packet Services, as above.
- **Domestic Managed Data Services + ETS LD:** Managed Network Service providing remote access connections from one or more customer locations. Also includes Enhanced Transport Service (ETS) used to manage a customer's physical network using a single point of contact and designated AT&T team for fault, configuration and performance management.
- **Domestic Managed Data Services + ETS Local:** Managed Network Service and Enhanced Transport Service contained in a local footprint.
- **International Packet:** High Speed Packet Services, including Frame Relay and ATM that have at least one endpoint in the US and one endpoint outside the US.
- **International Bandwidth:** International Private Line Services of varying speeds that have at least one endpoint in the US and one endpoint outside the US.
- **Specialized Federal Gov't Data Services:** Data services; Digital Access, Private Line, T-1.5, DDS, Frame Relay, Military T-45 and associated equipment provided to the Federal Government and other government entities within the "Government" category.

Domestic LD Voice

- **Outbound:** Standard Inter-LATA and Intra-LATA Long Distance Calling. for calls that both originate and terminate within the US, including Flat Rate Calling Plans.
- **Inbound:** Standard Inter-LATA and Intra-LATA Toll Free calling services including related Advanced Features. Domestic US service only.
- **Teleconferencing:** Revenues associated with voice, video and web conferencing services.
- **Card:** Revenue associated with Operator Assisted Calling, Calling Card revenue, and Directory Assistance.

HQ

- **HQ:** Billing associated with Access Reform- USF, late payment fees, Gross Receipts tax and miscellaneous adjustments across all product families.

International LD Voice

- **International LD Voice:** International switched services voice calls including Calling Card, USA Direct Services, and both Inbound and Outbound calling. Calls either originate domestically and terminate outside the US or originate Internationally and terminate in the US.

IP & Enhanced Services

- **Hosting:** Web Hosting and management services for clients' e-business applications.
- **VPN + EVPN:** Virtual Private Network services. Also may include a fully managed Internet Protocol (IP) network served by a Multi-Protocol Label Switched (MPLS) based IP-enabled network.
- **Dial:** Business Internet Services using dial-up connections at speeds up to 56Kbps.
- **E-Contact:** Services including; "AT&T Resource Manager" for advanced call routing for call centers, "AT&T Interactive Voice Service" providing automated voice response services and "AT&T Voice Tone" supporting web-enabled contact centers.
- **MIS:** Managed Internet Service providing high speed dedicated Internet Access. Includes monitoring services.
- **VoIP:** Managed Internet Service for Voice over Internet Protocol services.
- **DSL:** Digital Subscriber Line Service using conventional telephone lines for Internet access. Primarily sold to small and medium businesses or remote offices.

Local Voice

- **Local Voice:** Local Voice services including Business Lines, Trunks, Service Features and Local Area Calling.

Outsourcing and Professional Services

- **Solutions Product + Solutions IBM MSA:** Revenue associated with outsourcing contracts and networks, provided under a Managed Services Agreement, including provided to IBM globally through a Master Service Agreement.

- **Enterprise Networking CPE:** Revenue associated with Customer Premises equipment that is billed as an outsourced or professional service and maintained by AT&T.
- **Government Professional Services:** Professional Services provided specifically to the Federal Government including Hosting Services, Emergency Telephone Service
- **Messaging:** Professional Services supporting a customer's messaging platforms, including content hosting, software and information exchange platforms.

Specialized Federal Gov't LD Voice Services

- **Specialized Federal Gov't LD Voice Services:** Voice services provided to the Federal Government and other government entities within the "Government" category including; Access, Inbound and Outbound calling services and Calling Card services.
