On behalf of Enterprise Wireless Alliance ("EWA"), and in accordance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b), undersigned counsel hereby submits the instant notice of an *ex parte* presentation.

On July 20, 2005, Mark Crosby, President and CEO of EWA, together with undersigned counsel, met with John Branscome, Acting Legal Advisor for Wireless, Technology and International Issues to Commissioner Kathleen Q. Abernathy to discuss the background of the 900 MHz Business and Industrial/Land Transportation Pool spectrum, the role it might play in ensuring timely completion of the 800 MHz reconfiguration process, and regulatory approaches consistent with the FCC's objective of striking an equitable balance between the interests of incumbent B/ILT licensees and those providing geographic area service. The discussion addressed the views expressed in EWA's Reply Comments in WT Docket No. 05-62. They also discussed the Petitions for Reconsideration of the Commission's decision in ET Docket No. 04-151, including the Petition filed by EWA, and the need for a regulatory framework that will permit the use of this spectrum on a timely basis and with sufficient assurance of operational integrity and quality of service to attract investment by equipment manufacturers and operators.
