I do not accept solicitations by phone and prior to the "Do Not Call" law in Indiana, I regularly responded to telephone solicitations with "I am not interested and do not call me again," as soon as a solicitor called.

However, solicitors regularly interrupted my cherished family time in my home--robbing us of time and invading our privacy--and I resented it.

Since the Indiana law was enacted and I signed on, my privacy is protected and I can choose how I spend my time while in my home.

Do not violate my right to privacy.
