I am Arn Stolp, an avid listener of KRCL (community radio) in Salt Lake City and a strong believer that the media should be in the control of the people and not large corporations. I strongly support any actions the Federal Communications Commission can take to expand and support the Low Power FM radio service.

I don't think that low power radio stations should be displaced by full power stations, in fact, local low power stations should be able to displace non-locally-programmed translator stations. Low power stations should be able to be bought, sold, or transferred from one licensee to another entity as long as the buyer is not commercial.

In addition to low power FM stations we the public deserve far more community radio and television stations. I am very disturbed by the trend in media ownership toward greater and greater control by fewer and fewer people.
