Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 27, 2005 John Sumpter, Vice President Regulatory of Pac West Telecomm, Inc. and the undersigned met with Terri Natoli and William Kehoe of the Wireline Competition Bureau. Pac West expressed its view that as the FCC moves to address broadband internet access service provided by telecommunications carriers, it carefully address the obligations it is removing from such carriers, and just as importantly the obligations it is not removing. Pac West underscored the essential nature of interconnection obligations to intermodal as well as intramodal competition. The discussions are detailed in Pac West's comments in these proceedings.
