Re: SBC/AT&T: Mass Market Services Issues

Dear Ms. Dortch:

At the request of the Commission Staff, AT&T Corp. ("AT&T") submits with this letter a spreadsheet (both in CD-ROM and paper form) showing the number of AT&T's standalone long-distance customers ("SALD"). For each state, the spreadsheet identifies the number of AT&T SALD customers located in Verizon, SBC, Qwest and BellSouth territories, and the number of AT&T SALD customers located in areas served by independent telephone companies ("ITCs"). The data are provided for each month from January 2004 through June 2005.

To determine the local exchange carrier serving the region in which an AT&T long-distance customer is located, AT&T relied on existing records that have not been updated in some time to identify the local exchanges owned by each local exchange carrier holding company. Accordingly, the number of subscribers attributable to a particular local exchange carrier's territory in a state may be overstated if, for example, the carrier has sold local exchanges since the records were updated.
