

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Paxson Akron License, Inc. ("Paxson"), applicant for construction permit for WVPX-DT (Akron, Ohio) (the "Station"), by its attorneys, hereby requests waiver of the Commission's August 4, 2005 DTV construction deadline as set forth its *Second DTV Periodic Review Report and Order*.¹ Paxson has submitted a request for "flash cut" authority which, if granted, would allow the Station to forego construction of digital facilities on the paired allotment and thus obviate the need for compliance with this deadline. This "flash-cut" request remains pending. Accordingly, Paxson seeks waiver of the August 4th deadline until such time as the Commission has an opportunity to process the "flash-cut" request.
