

**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Station Resource Group, by its attorney and pursuant to Section 1.46 of the Commission's Rules, hereby respectfully requests a 30 day extension of the August 8, 2005 deadline by which comments and reply comments are due to be filed in the Further Notice of Proposed Rule Making in the above-captioned proceeding.

On July 7, 2005, the Commission's Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking ("FNPRM") in MM Docket 99-25 was published in the Federal Register. The FNPRM establishes an August 8, 2005 deadline for filing comments and an August 22, 2005 deadline for filing reply comments. SRG requests a 30-day extension of these deadlines, to and including September 7, 2005 and September 21, 2005 respectively.

Good cause exists for the requested extension. SRG's Annual Planning Retreat will be held August 3 - 5, 2005. The Annual Planning Retreat gathers representatives from major public radio stations around the country. Issues which are the subject of the FNPRM will be discussed at that meeting. SRG believes it will be able to submit more useful comments that better represent the views of its members after its Planning Retreat. It therefore requests a short extension of time to collect these ideas and compile related research.

Although SRG is reluctant to request an extension of time of any FCC proceeding, it believes that the requested extension will have little adverse impact in the present circumstances. In adopting the FNPRM, the Commission froze the processing of pending translator applications. That freeze preserves the status quo and prevents any immediate harm to interested parties.

Accordingly, SRG requests that the date for the filing of comments in the above-captioned proceeding be extended to September 7 and September 21, respectively.
