MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF FILING DEADLINE

1. On July 15, 2005,¹ San Francisco Unified School District ("SFUSD" or "District") filed a Motion seeking leave to move into the record its proposed Exhibit 79, a compilation of written public comments concerning the quality of programming of Station KALW(FM), San Francisco, California, which was submitted pursuant to section 73.3594 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 73.3594. Pursuant to section 1.205 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.205, the Enforcement Bureau ("Bureau") hereby moves for an extension of time to file its response to the Motion.

2. By e-mail dated July 25, 2005, Chief Administrative Law Judge Richard L. Sippel granted the Bureau's unopposed request for an extension to file its response. The Bureau's pleading is currently due by noon on July 29. Counsel for the District and the Bureau, however, have agreed in principle to enter into a stipulation that would likely obviate the need for the Bureau to so file.

3. It had been hoped that the parties would be able to agree to and enter into the stipulation by the current July 29 filing deadline. However, due to scheduling conflicts, we will not be able to do so by that date. SFUSD has committed to provide the Bureau with its draft



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stipulation by August 15, 2005. In order to permit the parties to review and finalize the language of the stipulation, the Bureau now requests that the deadline for filing its response to SFUSD's Motion be extended to September 7, 2005, should such a filing be necessary.

4. Counsel for the Bureau has informed SFUSD of this Motion and has been advised by counsel for SFUSD that the District will interpose no objection thereto.


