I am totally opposed to the violent actions the FCC has recently engaged in against 96.9FM in San Diego. I am also opposed to the ongoing attempts to silence 106.9FM in San Diego. The FCC has said that there are no more frequencies available for licensing in San Diego, so until LPFM is made legal, these stations are only exercising their Free Speech rights.
