I believe the FCC should reject the Petition for Reconsideration filed by Motorola, Redline, Intel, et.al around July 18, 2005 in regards to the 3650-3700 mhz band. I hope that the FCC stays with its original decision from a few months ago as I believe that original decision has much to offer in regards to creating vibrant new unlicensed wireless device markets akin to the 2.4 ghz band (and also 5.x ghz bands).
