On behalf of Gray Television Licensee, Inc., the licensee of KWTX-TV, Waco, Texas, its attorneys hereby submit the attached Negotiated Conflict Resolution Agreement (the "Agreement") by and between Gray Television Licensee, Inc. and CBS Stations Group of Texas, LP ("CBS"), the licensee of KTVT(TV), Fort Worth.

KWTX-TV is assigned analog channel 10 and digital channel 53. In its First Round Channel Election Application (FCC File No. BFRECT-20050126ALL) KWTX-TV elected to retain channel 10 for post-digital operations. On June 7, 2005, the Commission notified KWTX-TV that its election would result in impermissible interference of .5% to KTVT, Fort Worth, Texas.

The interference caused by KWTX-TV to KTVT(TV) has been resolved in two ways: First, KWTX-TV, is eligible for and has elected to take advantage of the special treatment afforded stations with only one in-core allotment, as this treatment is outlined in the Commission's public notice dated August 2, 2005. Second, KWTX-TV has entered into the attached Agreement with KTVT(TV), whereby KTVT(TV) has consented to accept the interference. In addition to a copy of the Agreement, an engineering statement is attached.
