Dear Ms. Dortch:

At the Commission Staff's request, AT&T Corp. ("AT&T") is providing supplemental information related to Specification 16(b)(4) of the Commission's April 18, 2005 Information and Document Request to AT&T. Specification 16(b)(4) states: "For each incumbent LEC franchise area, provide . . . the total number of residential access lines for which AT&T . . . is a local exchange carrier, and the number of lines for which the presubscribed interstate long distance carrier is AT&T, SBC, MCI, Sprint, Verizon, BellSouth, Qwest, or another long distance carrier." AT&T provided these data in the May 9, 2005 Response of AT&T Corp. To The Commission's April 18, 2005 Information And Document Requests.

The Commission Staff has requested that AT&T supplement its original response by providing the requested information for *all* states where AT&T has residential local access lines (not just SBC states). This information is provided in Highly Confidential Exhibit 16(b)-IV Supplement, which is provided with this letter on CD-ROM. In Tab 1 of the Exhibit, AT&T identifies, for each state, the number of residential access lines for which AT&T is a local exchange carrier. For California, the Exhibit identifies the number of those access lines separately for SBC and Verizon territories. In all other states, AT&T provides residential local access services only in areas served by the principal Regional Bell Operating Company. In Tab 2, AT&T identifies the number of those access lines for which AT&T is also the presubscribed

interstate long distance carrier. If the presubscribed interstate long distance carrier is a carrier other than AT&T, AT&T does not know the identity of the carrier.
