

We are a small rural business which has felt the effects of changes in government priorities, which has caused a major reduction in federal contracts for restoration businesses. We must, therefore, rely on broadband service - at an affordable price - to make our services known to a large rural public. Granting of the request for reconsideration to the large corporations which now wish to take advantage of the new band being made available will virtually guarantee that those corporations will monopolize the new band.
