On behalf of Nebraska Educational Telecommunications Commission (“NETC”), licensee of noncommercial educational television station KTNE (TV/DT), Alliance, Nebraska, and pursuant to “DTV Channel Election: First Round Conflict Decision Extension and Guidelines for Interference Conflict Analysis,” Public Notice, DA 05-2233, August 2, 2005 (“Public Notice”), we hereby submit the following information to supplement NETC’s election of its NTSC Channel 13 for station KTNE-DT, as reflected in its FCC Form 383 submission (FCC File No. BFR CET-20050719ACU):

-- A copy of an interference acceptance agreement (titled “Amended Negotiated Channel Election Conflict Resolution Agreement”) between NETC as licensee of KTNE-DT and NETC as licensee of noncommercial educational television station KRNE-DT, Merriman, Nebraska, pursuant to which NETC as licensee of KRNE-DT on Channel 12 has agreed to accept 0.2% interference from KTNE-DT as specified in the FCC’s letter of June 7, 2005; and

-- A copy of an Engineering Statement from NETC’s consulting engineer, Doug Vernier, which provides public interest justification for the Commission’s allowance of the specified level of interference from KTNE-DT to KRNE-DT.
