NEGOTIATED CONFLICT RESOLUTION AND INTERFERENCE AGREEMENT

This Negotiated Conflict Resolution and Interference Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into pursuant to the *Report and Order* in the *Second Periodic Review of the Commission's Rules and Policies Affecting the Conversion to Digital Television*, MB Docket No. 03-15, FCC 04-192, released by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") on Sept. 7, 2004. Parties to this Arrangement are Raycom Media, Inc., on behalf of its wholly-owned subsidiary, Raycom National License Subsidiary, LLC (collectively, "Raycom") and Tribune Company, on behalf of its wholly-owned subsidiary Tribune Broadcast Holdings, Inc. (collectively, "Tribune"). Raycom is the licensee of WXIX-TV and WXIX-DT ("WXIX"), Newport, KY. Tribune is the licensee and permittee, respectively, of WTTK(TV) and WTTK-DT ("WTTK"), Kokomo, IN.

Raycom currently holds FCC authorizations to transmit WXIX's analog signal on channel 19 and its DTV signal on channel 29. In the FCC Form 382, Raycom indicated an election of channel 29 for WXIX's post-DTV transition operation.

Tribune currently holds FCC authorizations to transmit WTTK's analog signal on channel 29 and its DTV signal on channel 54. In the FCC Form 382, Tribune indicated an election of channel 29 for WTTK's post-DTV transition operation.

On June 7, 2005, the FCC sent a letter to Tribune stating that WTTK's proposed post-DTV transition operation on channel 29 would create 0.5 percent impermissible interference to WXIX's elected DTV channel 29. The letter further states that Tribune may resolve the conflict by, among other options, "negotiating a conflict resolution agreement with the station(s) with which [WTTK is] in conflict."

In the post-transition environment, Raycom may wish to make certain changes to WXIX's operating parameters that could result in new interference by WXIX to 0.5 percent of WTTK's baseline service population.

To further an orderly DTV channel election process and serve the public's interest in access to over-the-air DTV services following the conclusion of the DTV transition, the parties agree as follows:

First, Raycom consents to Tribune's election of channel 29 for WTTK's post-transition operation and the resulting interference to 0.5 percent of WXIX's baseline service population.

Second, Tribune consents to the future creation of new interference by WXIX to 0.5 percent of WTTK's baseline service population. This interference allowance shall be in addition to any interference that may result to WTTK's channel 29 operations as a result of WXIX's operation using its existing licensed DTV parameters.


