To the Commission:

In general, this proposal conforms to the state of the art, and therefore, I support and urge its adoption by the Commission. I am concerned, however, that the Commission is eliminating the requirement, but leaving in CW subbands. I have no issue with recognizing Morse Code as a mode of communications and continuing to authorize its use, but if the point of this proposed regulation is to eliminate the Morse Code requirement for receipt of an amateur radio operator license, why should Morse Code subbands remain (as those reflect the existence of license classes that require Morse Code)? Just a thought that I hope the Commission will clarify in its rulemaking. Thank you!
