This letter responds to staff's request for additional information concerning the foreign destinations for international facilities-based traffic provided by Verizon and its U.S. affiliates. The attached document, which is Highly Confidential, provides the requested information.

In preparing this information, Verizon discovered that it had inadvertently included some traffic to U.S. points, including Hawaii, that should have been excluded from the facilities-based information previously provided. As a result, Verizon is providing a second revised Exhibit 2(a)-1, which contains Confidential information, and a revised summary chart, which contains Highly Confidential information.
