On Friday, September 2, 2005, Tim Harr and I on behalf of Motorola, and David Hilliard, counsel for Motorola, met with Mr. Fred Campbell, Wireless Advisor, Office of the Chairman. The purpose of the meeting was to underscore the importance of granting both the T-Mobile and Cingular waiver requests for HAC. With regard to the Cingular request, we explained the importance of the FCC's OET quickly informing the TCBs that they may grant HAC certification at 1900 MHz on multi-band handsets once any waiver is approved.
