MOTION TO ACCEPT SUPPLEMENT

Capstar TX Limited Partnership, CCB Texas Licenses, L.P., Clear Channel Broadcasting Licenses, Inc., and Rawhide Radio, L.L.C. (together, "Joint Parties") hereby request acceptance and consideration of the accompanying Supplement in the above-captioned case. This Supplement is filed to report a new decision which will impact this proceeding. On August 5, 2005, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit issued an Opinion in *Crawford v. FCC*, (No. 04-1031), in which it upheld the cut-off protection of the Joint Parties' pending proposal in MM Docket 00-148 against any later filed conflicting proposals. This Supplement will also answer allegations leveled against the Joint Parties for the first time in the reply comments filed by Munbilla Broadcasting Properties, Ltd. ("Munbilla").

The Commission may accept this Supplement as a matter within its discretion. See *Winslow, Camp Verde, Mayer and Sun City West, Arizona*, 15 FCC Rcd 9155 (2000); *Oakville, Raymond and South Bend, Washington*, 17 FCC Rcd 997. It should accept this pleading to complete the record in this proceeding.


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WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, the Commission should accept and consider the accompanying Supplement.

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


