Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 12, 2005, in response to the request of the staff, SBC submitted an ex parte identifying each of its wire centers with one or more fiber-based collocation arrangements, the number of such arrangements and the identity of the collocating entity.¹ In reviewing the data underlying the requested fiber collocation information, SBC has discovered that seven fiber-based collocation arrangements (none of which is an AT&T collocation arrangement) were inadvertently omitted from the August 12th filing. Of the seven affected wire centers, two already were reported to contain substantial numbers of fiber-based collocation arrangements,² while the remaining five were not on the previous list and have been added to the list of offices with one competitive carrier with fiber-based collocation each.³ Accordingly, SBC is submitting this erratum to its previous submission to provide an updated list of fiber-based collocators by wire center.

The data submitted herewith include highly confidential business information concerning the identity and characteristics of specific customers (*i.e.*, where those carriers have fiber
