## **Minor Amendment Reflecting Changes or Potential Changes in Foreign Affiliations**

In the applications SBC Communications Inc. (“SBC”) and AT&T Corp. (“AT&T”; collectively, the “Applicants”) have filed to transfer control of the cable landing licenses and international Section 214 authorizations held by AT&T and its subsidiaries,<sup>1</sup> SBC disclosed affiliations, by virtue of its ownership interest in Cingular Wireless LLC (“Cingular”), with carriers in the following countries: Anguilla; Antigua and Barbuda; Barbados; Bermuda; Cayman Islands; Curaçao, Netherlands Antilles; Dominica; the French West Indies islands of Guadeloupe, Martinique, Saint-Barthélemy, and Saint-Martin; Grenada; Jamaica; St. Kitts and Nevis; St. Lucia; and St. Vincent and the Grenadines. Subsequently, Cingular entered into a contract to sell these carriers,<sup>2</sup> and SBC understands from Cingular that the transaction closed on September 1, 2005 with respect to the carriers in Anguilla; Bermuda; Curaçao, Netherlands Antilles; Dominica; and Jamaica and on September 27, 2005 with respect to the carrier in St. Kitts and Nevis. Closing of the remainder of the sale is contingent upon governmental and regulatory approvals<sup>3</sup> and may occur, at least in part, in the near future. Although these affiliations are not material to the merger, the Applicants will endeavor to notify the Commission promptly of the deaffiliations. Nevertheless, given the timing, it is possible that they will not be able to do so between the deaffiliations and the time the Commission adopts its order in this merger proceeding.

Minor Amendment Reflecting Changes or Potential Changes in Foreign Affiliations

Additionally, AT&T reports that on June 16, 2005, it reported to the Commission its acquisition of a new foreign affiliate, AT&T Communications Services de Panama S. de R.L. ("AT&T Panama"). As reported in its foreign affiliate notification, Panama is a member of the World Trade Organization. As demonstrated in the notification, AT&T Panama is entitled to non-dominant classification on the route between the United States and Panama, because AT&T Panama does not possess market power on the route, having less than a 50% share in all relevant markets on the foreign end of the route. AT&T also has reported that the new affiliation does not create any interlocking directorates, and that neither AT&T nor its affiliates has agreed to, or will agree to, accept any special concessions from any foreign carrier with respect to any U.S. international route where the foreign carrier possesses market power on the foreign end of the route.


