

The frequencies in question are crucial for expansion of broadband internet access for areas which are ill served for various reasons that have to do with market forces and current telecommunications provider decisions.

Prior FCC decisions to create unlicensed bands and encourage innovative use of such unlicensed frequencies have borne fruit that have been evidenced by the provision of wireless VOIP being set up by Wireless ISPs in some locations where all other forms of communication were out of service for the general public.

This is a challenge and pivotal point to further serve the general public in ways that will be seen historically as on par with the invention of the Internet Protocol at DARPA. I support 04-186 and look forward to seeing its benefits for our nation as a whole.
