This is to inform you that, on October 3, 2005, Susan Eid, Larry Hunter, Dan Fawcett, and undersigned counsel on behalf of DIRECTV, Inc. ("DIRECTV") met with Jordan Goldstein, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Copps, to discuss DIRECTV's comments in the above-captioned proceeding. In particular, DIRECTV discussed how Comcast Corp. ("Comcast") and Time Warner Cable Inc. ("Time Warner") have arranged to withhold or raise the cost of key regional sports programming in a number of markets, and why approval of the transactions at issue in this proceeding without appropriate conditions would enable Comcast and Time Warner to pursue similar strategies in many more markets.
