On October 14, 2005 Timothy Lorello SVP, Chief Marketing Officer TeleCommunication Systems ("TCS"), Dick Dickenson, TCS Director, Public Safety and H. Russell Frisby, Jr. of the law firm of Kirkpatrick & Lockhart Nicholson Graham met, in connection with the above-reference proceeding, with the following Commissioners and their staff: Commissioner Michael Copps and Jessica Rosenworcel, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Copps; Commissioner Kathleen Abernathy and Russell Hanser, Acting Legal Advisor for Wireline Competition Issues; and Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein and Scott Bergmann, Legal Advisor Commissioner Adelstein.
