David Jones, President of the National Emergency Number Association (“NENA”), and Patrick Halley, NENA’s Government Affairs Director, met today with Chairman Martin and Michelle Carey on the subjects of VOIP enhanced 9-1-1.

We discussed NENA’s August request to Wireless Competition Bureau Chief Thomas Navin for the appointment of a Routing Number Administrator to manage the assignment of pseudo-Automatic Number Identifications (“pANIs”) used in both wireless and VOIP non-fixed calling, as well as NENA’s Selective Router directory, which aims for completion at the end of October. We also provided an update on the efforts of several NENA Working Groups that are addressing various VoIP E9-1-1 implementation issues. We repeated our belief that pending national legislation on VOIP should augment rather than override the FCC May order.
