On October 21, 2005, COMPTTEL filed an ex parte letter in the above-referenced dockets. The letter, as filed, contained a typographical error. On page 4 of the letter, the first sentence of the second paragraph read “COMPTTEL suggests that, within five years, 50% of SBC and Verizon out-of-region special access usage, as measured by, be met by non-ILEC providers (competitive providers or by self-deployment).” The sentence should read, “COMPTTEL suggests that, within five years, 50% of SBC and Verizon out-of-region special access usage, as measured by **revenue**, be met by non-ILEC providers (competitive providers or by self-deployment).” (emphasis added) A corrected version has been filed as an attachment to this letter.
