

This is a petition for review of the actions of BellSouth in response to FCC 05-150 In the Matters of Appropriate Framework for Broadband Access to the Internet over Wireline Facilities. BellSouth has repealed acces to 3MB DSL service to unaffiliated ISPs as of 11/16/05. This is still a tariffed service until the order takes effect in 9 months. Tariffed services are available for purchase by unaffiliated ISPs as well as the BellSouth Internet Group. BellSouth has overstepped its borders here as well as the spirit of the order, which was to give ISPs access for a transition period of one year. Not to cut them off at the knees with a 2 week notice. We request that the WCB and the Enforcement Bureau review these actions in light of the FCC Order FCC 05-150.
