Please accept this Subscriber Acknowledgement Report for November 28, 2005 on behalf of WestCom LLC dba WesTelFiber (fka Digital Easy Chair).

- As of August 5, 2005, WesTelFiber sent out the required notices, labels and subscriber acknowledgements to all eighty-two (82) of their VoIP customers.
- As of November 28, 2005, ninety-eight percent (98%) or eighty (80) customers had signed and returned their Acknowledgements.
- WesTelFiber continues attempting to make personal contact with the two (2) remaining customers who have not returned their Acknowledgements to date.
- WesTelFiber provides 911 services in compliance with the rules established in the *VoIP 911 Order* and always has. WesTelFiber provides 911 services through indirect wireline connection.
- WesTelFiber interconnects with a provider of wholesale VoIP services and provides them with the required information for each subscriber to accurately populate the ALI/ANI database.
- The wholesale provider purchases wireline Primary Rate Service as their interconnection method with the PSTN from a CLEC and provides the ANI/ALI information to the CLEC, who is interconnected directly to 100% of the PSAPs in their service area (Boise, Idaho metro area).
- The wholesale VoIP provider transports a 911 call from 100% of WesTelFiber's customers over Primary Rate Service. The CLEC, who interconnects directly with all of the PSAPs in the Boise metro area, transmits the customer's ANI/ALI to the appropriate PSAP over their direct connections to each PSAP.

- WesTelFiber provides stationary VoIP service so the customer's Registered Location does not change.
