
By Associate General Counsel, Administrative Law Division:

1. Now before the Commission are: (1) Family Broadcasting, Inc.'s Exceptions to the Initial Decision on Remand of Chief Administrative Law Judge,<sup>1</sup> filed June 9, 2005; and (2) Enforcement Bureau's Reply to Exceptions of Family Broadcasting, Inc., filed June 22, 2005.

2. It is the Commission's policy, in adjudicatory proceedings pending before the Commission for issuance of a final order or decision, to act within five months of the last responsive pleading or else issue an order indicating that additional time will be required. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 0.251(d). In this proceeding, additional time is required for resolution of issues raised by the pleadings.

3. ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to the authority set forth in 47 C.F.R. § 0.251(d), that additional time WILL BE REQUIRED for disposition of the pleadings in this proceeding.
