Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(2) of the Commission's Rules, this is to notify you that on November 30, 2005, Steve Sharkey and Kimberly Baum of Motorola had a meeting with Bruce Franca, Julius Knapp, Karen Rackley and Alan Scrimme of the Office of Engineering and Technology regarding the above captioned proceedings.

We discussed the potential for interference between ISM devices and BRS receivers operating in the 2496-2500 MHz band, the upper edge of the 2400-2500 MHz ISM band. As described in detail in the attached presentation, Motorola performed a technical analysis which demonstrates a significant potential for interference into BRS receivers. To reduce the potential for interference to and provide a more stable operating environment for BRS operations, Motorola recommends the application of limits on ISM devices in the 2496-2500 MHz band, e.g., extension of the Part 18 limits which apply above 2500 MHz to this additional 4 MHz as the WCA and Sprint Nextel have proposed.
