On December 2, 2005 the undersigned counsel for TMI Communications and Company Limited Partnership (TMI), Robert H. Brumley, President and Chief Executive Officer of TerreStar Networks, Inc (TerreStar) and Al Mattur, consultant to TerreStar, met with Commissioner Jonathan S. Adelstein and Barry Ohlson, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Adelstein. At the meeting, Mr. Brumley furnished Commissioner Adlestein and Mr. Ohlson with a copy of the TerreStar background information and letters of support that were previously filed as an ex parte in the above referenced dockets on November 22, 2005.
