**BUCKEYE CABLEVISION, INC. d/b/a BUCKEYE CABLESYSTEM  
MOTION TO ACCEPT LATE-FILED COMPLIANCE LETTER**

Buckeye Cablevision, Inc. ("Buckeye CableSystem") files this Motion to accept its late-filed Compliance Letter under 47 CFR § 1.205.

1. Buckeye CableSystem provides interconnected VoIP services over its cable facilities. Since it began providing its VoIP services, Buckeye CableSystem has been in compliance with the customer notification and acknowledgement requirements issued by the FCC for interconnected VoIP service providers.
2. Section 9.5(f) of the FCC's rules requires that interconnected VoIP service providers file with the FCC by November 28, 2005 a Compliance Letter detailing their compliance with Section 9.5.
3. Buckeye CableSystem's personnel timely filed the November 28, 2005 compliance letter for Buckeye CableSystem's affiliate, Buckeye TeleSystem, Inc., but due to an administrative oversight, failed to file a compliance letter for Buckeye CableSystem. As soon as it became aware of the oversight, Buckeye CableSystem contacted counsel to prepare and file its Compliance Letter and

this Motion. The filing confirmation for the Compliance Letter is attached as Exhibit 1.

4. 47 CFR § 1.205 provides:

Continuances of any proceeding or hearing and extensions of time for making any filing or performing any act required or allowed to be done within a specified time may be granted by the Commission or the presiding officer upon motion for good cause shown, unless the time for performance or filing is limited by statute.

5. Good cause exists in this case. Accepting Buckeye CableSystem's Compliance Letter is in the public interest, as the Compliance Letter will provide the Bureau with a more complete and accurate record of the status of compliance with the Commission's E911 rules for interconnected VoIP providers. *See, e.g., In the Matter of Rules and Regulations Implementing the Telephone Consumer Protection Act of 1991, Report and Order, 18 FCC Rcd. 14,014 (2003) at ¶ 220. See also, In the Matter of Bell Atlantic Progress Report on Compliance with Bell Atlantic/NYNEX Merger Order Conditions, Order, 14 FCC Rcd. 4403 (1999) at ¶ 6.*

6. Further, the November 28, 2005 deadline is not required by any statute, accordingly, the Commission has the authority to grant the requested extension.

7. Finally, accepting Buckeye CableSystem's Compliance Letter will not prejudice any person, especially considering that the compliance letter is less than 10 days late and that Buckeye CableSystem is in full compliance with Section 9.5 of the FCC's rules.

8. In order to provide a full and complete record in this docket, and because no person will be prejudiced by acceptance of Buckeye CableSystem's Compliance

Letter, Buckeye CableSystem requests that the Enforcement Bureau accept its late-filed Compliance Letter.
