REQUEST FOR MODIFICATION OF REGION VI PLAN

The Northern California NPSPAC Region VI hereby submits the proposed modified

Regional Plan and requests the Commission to approve the Plan as submitted.

As will be noted in the attached information, the Regional Review and Revision

Committee has held several open meeting that were attended by all interested parties.

The Plan as now submitted is a consensus of all those present at the meetings and was

unanimously approved by the Committee. It will not only improve the management of the

Region VI spectrum, but will facilitate the re-banding process now underway in the Region.

SUMMARY

In preparation for the mandated re-banding, a re-packing plan was combined in the process

and preparation for narrow banding incorporation in Project 25 type equipment was initiated.

The final document incorporates changes that will result in better use of the spectrum both

now and in the future. It will also facilitate timely action on changes required to create

new systems and to expand existing systems.

CONCLUSION

Therefore, the Commission should approve the Plan as submitted for the reasons discussed above.
