Background

The Comporium Companies (“Companies”) comprise the following three affiliates all of which operate exclusively within South Carolina and each of which is an individual issuing carrier for John Staurulakis, Inc. Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 (“JSI Tariff FCC No. 1”):

The Companies provide wireline broadband Internet access service (WBIAS) through Asymmetric Digital Subscriber Line (“ADSL”) Service described in Section 16.2 of JSI Tariff FCC No. 1. These regulations mirror those in National Exchange Carrier Association Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 (“NECA Tariff FCC No. 5”) for ADSL Access Service. NECA regulations for ADSL Access Service are at Section 8.1 of NECA Tariff FCC No. 5.

The rates applicable to each of the Companies’ ADSL Service are numbered as follows within JSI Tariff FCC No. 1.

Impact on Customers

The only customer for the Companies’ ADSL Service is the nonregulated operations of the respective Companies. The nonregulated operations of each of the Companies purchases the ADSL Service for use as a component in its broadband Internet service sold to consumers and business customers. The cancellation of the tariffed ADSL service will have no effect on the end user service provided by Comporium.

Note: JSI will provide the Wireline Competition Bureau-Pricing Policy Division (Pricing) with an advance draft and will address any concerns of the Pricing as appropriate, including the filing date.

January 11, 2006

Cancellation of tariff pages effective.

Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) and NECA Tariff FCC No. 4 indicate removal of ADSL and DSL Access Connection points for Companies.

January 11, 2006 Forward

Companies account for WBIAS costs as exclusion from interstate special access revenue requirement.

Companies assess Federal Universal Service Charges (FUSC) on WBIAS based on current level of such charges – through the 270-day period ordered in the *Wireline Broadband Order*.


