Yesterday, Chase Carey, Larry Hunter, Susan Eid, and I met with Commissioner Cops and his legal advisor Jordan Goldstein to discuss the Adelphia-Comcast-Time Warner transactions. Our discussions reflected DIRECTV's comments and surreply filed in MB Docket No. 05-192. In particular, we discussed how the transactions would increase Comcast's and Time Warner's incentive and ability to withhold "must have" regional sports programming, and how the transactions might be conditioned to prevent such an outcome.
