PROPOSED RULE ON BLOCKING OF INTERNET ENABLED TRS ACCESS

Each provider of Internet-enabled text, voice, or video relay services authorized to provide telecommunications relay service under section 225 has the duty not to restrict users either contractually or technically, to a single telecommunications Internet-enabled text, voice, or video relay service provider or otherwise intentionally block calls to or from the relay equipment or services of any other provider.
