Dear Mr. Kelly:

On behalf of TeleBEEPER of New Mexico, Inc. ("TeleBEEPER"), this letter serves to notify the 800 MHz Transition Administrator that TeleBEEPER will elect to relocate the above-referenced 800 MHz EA Licenses to the new ESMR portion of the 800 MHz band (862-869 MHz).

It just came to TeleBEEPER's attention that the initial filing window for ESMR elections has already passed. However, TeleBEEPER understands that a new filing window will be opened for cellular-architecture systems that do not meet the definition of high density cellular systems.¹ TeleBEEPER's system will fall within this class of cellular-architecture systems. The Company intends to file its ESMR election once the TA opens this new 20-day election window.

In the meantime, TeleBEEPER wants to establish for the record that its system will be a cellular-architecture system, and that it has an interest in relocating to the ESMR portion of the 800 MHz band.
