On January 9, 2006, Jim Coltharp, representing Comcast Corporation (“Comcast”), Steven Teplitz and Susan Mort, representing Time Warner Inc. (“Time Warner”), and the undersigned, representing Adelphia Communications Corp. (“Adelphia”), (collectively, the “Applicants”) met with Rudy Brioche, Legal Advisor for Media Issues in Commissioner Adelstein’s office, regarding the above-captioned proceeding.

Applicants described the many public interest benefits associated with the proposed transactions, including accelerated rollout of advanced services, greater emphasis on local communities and local programming, increased competition that will result from geographic rationalization, unwinding of Comcast’s interest in Time Warner Cable, and the facilitation of Adelphia’s exit from bankruptcy. The discussion was consistent with documents that Applicants have previously filed in this proceeding.
