Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter provides notice to the Commission that on or about March 1, 2006, Verizon will discontinue the Private Label Digital Subscriber Line (“DSL”) Access, Private Label DSL Internet, and ReachDSL wholesale services that were offered by MCI.² Currently, there are approximately 90 customers for these wholesale DSL products in the District of Columbia and the following states: Arizona, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Massachusetts, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, North Carolina, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Texas, Utah, Virginia, Washington, and Wisconsin. The planned discontinuance will affect the provision of these wholesale DSL services only, and will not affect any other wholesale product or service that these customers may have purchased from MCI or Verizon.

On December 14, 2005, MCI notified affected customers of its intent to discontinue these wholesale DSL services and that any other wholesale products and services purchased from MCI

will not be affected by this action. MCI also directed customers to contact their Wholesale Sales Representatives to address any questions or concerns that may arise during the withdrawal transition period.

A copy of this letter has been submitted to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications for the Secretary of Defense, the Governor and the Public Utility Commission of each state in which the discontinuance is proposed, and the Mayor and the Public Utility Commission of the District of Columbia.


