

Dear Sirs:

I am opposed to RM-11306. This proposal only complicates the issue by creating more sub-bands based on bandwidth rather than keeping it simple with the two that we already have: CW/Data and Phone. My suggestion would be to adopt the CTT's RM-11305 proposal with a modification: Allow flexibility of all legal modes in the HF spectrum to transmit on any given frequency within a particular amateur radio band such as CW currently enjoys, but re-evaluate the current CW/Data and Phone sub-bands to allow greater spectrum for phone or image operation. This makes more sense, as the lion's share of operation in the HF spectrum is Phone. We need the flexibility, but we also need the boundaries to keep things in check. If we do not, we will create a new version of 'inter-modal warfare' within the Amateur Radio fraternity.
