During the meeting, the representatives of WABC stressed the following points: (1) that WABC continues to believe that remaining on channel 7 is the best way to serve its viewers; (2) that the predicted interference to WNJB occurs largely in areas of New York; (3) that WABC has presented alternative solutions that would accomplish WNJB's stated goals of serving viewers in New Jersey and permit WABC to remain on channel 7; (4) that WABC would like to work with WNJB to achieve a cooperative solution; and (5) that co-location of WNJB's facilities on the Empire State Building is not feasible.

The representatives of WABC also responded briefly to WNJB's new proposal to locate its facilities at Four Times Square, in New York City, raising concerns, but pledging to review carefully the technical parameters of any such proposal.
