

**STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE FCC'S CUSTOMER
PROPRIETARY NETWORK INFORMATION
(CPNI) RULES**

CHOICE WIRELESS LC's Operating Procedures ensure that it is in compliance with the rules of 47 CFR, C1, Part 64.2009.

Prefatory Statement: Our Company has elected not to utilize or provide CPNI for any purpose other than those purposes that are permissible without customer approval in accordance with Section 64.2005 of the FCC's Rules and Regulations. We provide our customers notification of their rights with respect to their CPNI and we have adopted the procedures set forth below to ensure our familiarity and compliance with the applicable rules in the event that we subsequently elect to utilize or provide CPNI for any purpose that requires customer approval.

- 1. When the customer signs up for service they are provided written notification of their right to restrict use of, disclosure of, and access to their customer proprietary network information (CPNI). The notification states that the company has a duty under federal law to protect the confidentiality of the CPNI.**
- 2. The notification specifies the types of information that constitute the CPNI and the specific entities that will receive the CPNI, the purpose for which the CPNI will be used, and information of the customer's right to disapprove those uses, and deny or withdraw CPNI at anytime.**
- 3. The customer is provided precise steps the customer must take in order to grant or deny access to CPNI. It also states that denial of approval will not affect the services they subscribe to in any way.**
- 4. The customer notification clearly states that any approval or denial for the use of CPNI outside of the service to which the customer already subscribes from this company is valid until the customer revokes or limits such approval or denial.**
