On February 3, 2006, A. Richard Metzger, Jr. and the undersigned of Lawler, Metzger, Milkman & Keeney, LLC, counsel to Sorenson Communications, met with Scott Bergmann, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein. During that meeting, representatives for Sorenson explained that any decision to require unbundling of the VRS platform must ensure that VRS companies continue to have incentives to develop, install and maintain equipment in the manner necessary to ensure that users of American Sign Language have access to VRS. Representatives for Sorenson discussed several alternative proposals that would help preserve such incentives, including the use of revenue sharing arrangements.

Pursuant to the Commission's rules, this letter is being submitted for inclusion of the public record in the above-referenced proceeding.
