On February 17, 2006, Jim Coltharp of Comcast Corporation (“Comcast”), Arthur Burke of Davis Polk & Wardwell, Michael Hammer of Willkie Farr & Gallagher LLP, and the undersigned had a telephone conversation with Tracy Waldon and Royce Sherlock of the Media Bureau regarding the above-captioned proceeding. The conversation focused on Bureau questions regarding the DMA-level subscriber data for Comcast submitted in a letter dated June 21, 2005, by Arthur Harding of Fleischman and Walsh, LLP. Comcast explained that the estimates of DMA-level subscriber data were derived by assigning subscribers to a particular DMA on a system-by-system basis.
