This is to advise you, in accordance with Section 1.1206 of the FCC's rules, that on February 24, 2006, George Mahoney, Vice President, General Counsel and Secretary of Media General, Inc. ("Media General"); John Feore of this firm; and I met with Catherine C. Bohigian, Chief, Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis, to discuss the positions Media General has previously taken in the above-referenced dockets and procedural issues related to following up on the remand of the July 2005 decision in these dockets by the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit. Media General emphasized the need for the FCC to move expeditiously to repeal the newspaper/broadcast cross-ownership rule, which has remained unchanged for 30 years.
