On February 23, 2006, Susan Mort of Time Warner Inc. ("Time Warner") and the undersigned had a telephone conversation with Tracy Waldon of the Media Bureau regarding the above-captioned proceeding. The discussion related to an apparent computational error in Exhibit II(B)(1) to the response submitted by Time Warner to the Bureau's Information and Document Request dated December 5, 2005. Specifically, on the spreadsheet covering the second quarter of 2005, the telephony homes passed figure for Time Warner Cable's Houston Division should be revised from 590,000 to 1,180,000.
