COUNTERPROPOSAL

Linda Crawford hereby submits this counterproposal to the *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*, DA 06-109 (rel. January 20, 2006) in the above-captioned proceeding. Counter proponent proposes to allot a first service to Rochester, Texas in lieu of a potentially second service to Crowell, Texas as proposed by the original NPRM in this proceeding.

DISCUSSION

In order for Channel 288C2 to be allotted at Rochester, Texas, two vacant allotments will need to be replaced with equivalent channels, Channel 291A/ Know City and Channel 293C3/ Crowell. The substitution of channel 293C3 with channel 250C3 at Crowell provides the conflict with the NPRM.

The proposed changes are:

Rochester, Texas 288C2. 1st Service

Counter proponent respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 288C2 to Rochester, Texas as that community's first local service. Rochester, Texas is an incorporated community of 378 people.¹ Rochester, Texas has its own post office, city hall, mayor, volunteer fire department and its own school district, the Rochester Independent School District, Steven Self, superintendent. Rochester is also home to a number of local churches. Rochester is a community that is certainly deserving of a local service. "Local radio stations play an important role in their communities, providing local news, information and entertainment to residents, and generally serving as good corporate citizens in the local community life. This is particularly true in smaller towns, where the radio stations are limited in number. Yet there are still rural areas of our country that do not have even a local radio station."² The proposed

channel 288C2 will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Rochester residents and therefore is in the public interest.

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that Channel 288C2 can be allocated to Rochester, Texas, consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules, provided the two changes are made at Knox City and Crowell. See revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992). (See, Attachment A) Reference coordinates for Channel 288C2 at Rochester, Texas are:

In order for Channel 288C2 to be allotted at Rochester, Texas, the vacant allotment for Channel 291A at Knox City, Texas will need to be replaced with Channel 293A. Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that channel 293A can be allocated to Know City, Texas consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules provided the vacant allotment for Channel 293C3 at Crowell, Texas is moved to channel 250C3. See revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992). (See, Attachment B)

In order for channel 293A to be allotted at Knox City, Texas, the vacant allotment for channel 293C3 at Crowell, Texas must be replaced with Channel 250C3. Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that channel 250C3 can be allocated to Crowell, Texas consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules. See revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992). (See, Attachment C) Also note: the petitioner to add channel 251A at Electra, Texas, filed a Motion to Dismiss on December 2, 2005. This is an effective but not yet final dismissal. See, Auburn, Alabama. (See, Attachment D)
