On Thursday March 9, 2006, Timothy Totten, Wireless Manager, United Parcel Service, Inc. (UPS); Mark Crosby, President and CEO, Enterprise Wireless Alliance (EWA); Elizabeth Sachs, Principal, Lukas, Nace, Gutierrez & Sachs, Chartered; and Scott Delacourt, Of Counsel, Wiley, Rein & Fielding LLP met with Julius Knapp, Lauren VanWazer, Bruce Romano, Alan Scime, and Jamison Prime of the Office of Engineering and Technology to discuss issues arising in the above-captioned dockets.
